

Center of Social and Civic Involvement

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The goal of Center for Social and Civic Involvement is to elevate the comprehensive knowledge of continuing educational students (adult) and high educational institutions, which will help them to be involved in different practical activities.

Subject/Topics: Politics , law, human rights, culture , religion, history, media, economy, environment protection and sustainable development, intellectual/cognitive development and critical thinking.

TASKS:

1. Cooperation - with non-governmental organizations and with the similar centres of the participating and non-participating Universities;
2. To inform students about civic educational issues in every step of the study process and to gain practical experience by the participating in the activities organized by the centre.
3. To issue the certificates in order to elevate students' motivation, to make a CV look more professional and to get the scholarships.
4. To organize the public lectures and scientific events regarding the issues of civic education.
5. To change the current practice and civic experience to outdoor civic activities.
6. To demonstrate the knowledge about civic educational issues and to use it in practice. to organize educational trips and contests.

The following persons will be the members of Center for Social and Civic Involvement / beneficiaries of the center

1. Academic and administrative personal, students and interested people
2. Students' membership will be available upon their request.

The Board of the Center for Social and Civic Involvement:

The Head of the Center for Social and Civic Involvement will be the center's council and a person in charge for the center's activities.

Minimum of 3 members must be on board of the Center for Social and Civic Involvement.

The decision will be made by the Board together with the Head of the Civic Involvement Centre.

The head of Center for Social and Civic Involvement will be the person in charge from the Academic faculty of the University.

Head of the Civic Involvement Centre will be elected every 2 years.

Initially the center will be functioning at the Faculty, however it can expanded its activities and at the University level.

Center for Social and Civic Involvement has to be fully functioning no later than November 2017.

The discussions regarding getting credits can be possible at the faculty council meetings. Auditoriums will be facilitated for the training purposes of the Center for Social and Civic Involvement, if required.
