



Community Placemaking CURE program at Givat Washington College 2017-2020

Abstract: In order to motivate Reggev fraternity student engagement, we have embarked on a process based on participatory leadership approach and incorporates tools such as placemaking, world coffee, graphic illustration and more, to formulate group responsibilities, to realize the college, and to promote its dissemination in the Reggev student work spaces.

Three Year Process -

2017 - A workshop process for formulating and training the group for hosting a world coffee at the college.

2018 - A participatory action plan to realize the insights and initiatives that have emerged at Cafe World. Training in Plismaking. Realizing college interventions.

2019-20 - Move It On - Students are leading the model of doing in their experience spaces including college

2020 - The process:

- Knowledge and Storytelling - a methodology that will incorporate listening and researching tools to learn and gain the best and best insights from last year's process, by the veteran students and new students.
- Theory and training for guidance in the art of hosting approach.
- Building an Action Plan for 2019 - Working in Action Teams. Field selection for impact / intervention according to student skills and college need.
- Experience in Community Place Making Experience - a civic influence through democratic dialogue, in the public spaces of the college in the way students choose.
- Space intervention - realizing the social activities of the college students.
- The entire process of learning and planning for next year.
